PRESS NOTE

REPOLLS

The Commission, after scrutiny of reports received from the Observers, Returning Officers and other quarters and taking all other relevant inputs, has today ordered repoll in 821 Polling Stations covering 44 Parliamentary Constituencies. The break-up of the Polling Stations covered are - 700 Polling Stations spread over 30 Parliamentary Constituencies in the State of Bihar and 121 Polling Stations covered in 14 Parliamentary Constituencies in the State of Uttar Pradesh. These are in addition to the repolls ordered by the Commission on 17th February, 1998.

POLL DATE - COIMBATORE PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY

The Commission has taken note of the prevailing situation in the southern city of Coimbatore. After taking into account the reports from different sources and all other relevant inputs, the Commission has unanimously decided to re-schedule the polls in the Constituency No.20 Coimbatore in the State of Tainil Nadu on the 28th of February, 1998. Formal notification is being issued separately.
